## Ammoniated Zinc Chloride 10%

### Product Specifications:

Ammoniated Zinc Chloride 10% is a liquid zinc source which is specially formulated to contain both macronutrients (N) with essential micronutrients (Zn). Zinc is used in cellular plant growth above and below the soil. Ammoniated Zinc Chloride is recommended for crops requiring high levels of zinc, for instance corn, beans and cotton.

**Caution: while Ammoniated Zinc Chloride 10% is compatible with most liquid fertilizers a small scale (jar test) should be conducted prior to use.**

### Recommended Rates:

Rates should be determined on the basis of a soil and/or plant tissue analysis. In the absence of test results the following can be used as a guide:

### Broadcast Applications:

Severe Deficiency .....	4 qts per acre
Slight Deficiency .....	2 qts per acre
Maintenance .....	1 pint per acre

### Row Application:

Use at a rate of 1-2 qts per acre as a supplement to broadcast applications.
